

Crate Engine Rules and Guidelines

(Revised 12-16-21)

Below are the guidelines for using a crate engine in CRA Street Stock events. These rules are considered to be under development and CRA officials have the right to alter them at any time, at their discretion.

- 1. Teams may use the 602 or 604 Chevrolet Crate engine in the original, unaltered form with the original, unaltered seals from Chevrolet. These engines cannot be re-built or blueprinted. If the engine is need of legitimate repairs, it must be done at MEP with CRA seals.
- 2. When using these engines, there will be no additional weight penalty for use of aluminum intakes or use of headers.
- 3. Teams may use any carburetor allowed in the CRA Street Stock rules.
- 4. Teams must provide proof of ability to verify that a 6500 rpm limiting device is used.
- Teams using a 604 engine may deduct 100 lbs on ½ mile tracks (excluding LOR). Teams using the 602 engine package may deduct 50 lbs of total weigh and 150 lbs on ½ mile tracks (excluding LOR), and may run 58% max left side weight.
