Qualifying Procedures: Each car will be given two (2) qualifying laps with the best lap establishing their qualifying time. CARS OUT OF ORDER FOR PRE-QUALIFYING TECH INSPECTION MAY BE PENALIZED ONE LAP OF QUALIFYING. The top 16 qualifiers will transfer directly into feature event with an invert of roll plus **9** (10-15) and will contest odd/even heats, fully inverted with points awarded. The remainder of cars will be split into one or two qualifying races with a total of four (4) cars transferring into feature to fill positions 17-20. Cars not transferring will run a last chance race(s), with starting positions being straight up from qualifying race finish order with a total of 4 cars transferring into positions 21-24.

Provisional Starting Positions: In order to be eligible for provisional starting position, car must be deemed to make every attempt to transfer by traditional means. Position 25-26 highest in 2025 ASAMT Points (top 20), Position 27 reserved for most recent Trickle Segment winner and/or Overall Trickle winner not yet in field. Position 28 reserved for most recent Sunday Oktoberfest Headline Feature Winner not yet in field. When no eligible cars are available for a Provisional prior to Last Chance event, additional transfer(s) will be awarded from Last Chance event to fill field at tail of field. If no eligible cars are available for a Provisional following Last Chance event, fastest non-transferring car from qualifying will fill Provisional at tail of field.

Feature Event: 200 lap feature event with yellow flags counting until last ten laps of event. Controlled pit stops will be utilized at this event, no car may lose a lap under caution while pitting, no car will lose positions in regards to other cars that pitted under same caution period. Minimum pit open will be four laps (these laps will NOT count) under each caution, unless declared a 'Quickie Yellow'. If span of green flag laps goes 50 laps without a caution, a 'Competition Caution' will be utilized in the next 15 laps.

Last Chance 15 laps: 1-4. Transfer, Non-transfers \$500, \$475, \$450, \$425, \$400, \$375, \$350 ROF/Min \$300

The number of transfer positions/starting field may be adjusted based on car count. All cars transferring from Last Chance event will forfeit Last Chance awards.

Points: Awarded based on 2025 ASA Midwest Tour Point Table.

Special Event Bulletin: Chevrolet ACE Engine allowed at 2700 lbs with 8,000 RPM limit.

Practice: NOTICE there will be no private practice allowed for one week prior to this event, Last Day for Private Test Friday September 26. Teams will be permitted to participate in scheduled 'open practice(s)' at host track during this time, including Saturday Sept 27 from 11am-3pm, Wednesday October 1, Thursday October 2 and Friday October 3. Any team found to participate in a private test within that one week window will have their qualifying time disallowed and will start at the back of the transfer race and can start no greater than 17th in the feature field.

ASA Midwest Tour Official Entry Form

Tires: Approved Tire Combination(s) for this event Hoosier ST1 left and Hoosier ST2 right), all new tires for race must be purchased at event from approved tire vendor. Tires can be pre-ordered for at track delivery by calling Dave Grueneberg at 608-513-2278. This is a six (6) tire race. Tires will be impounded and scanned. Once your tire is mounted we will NOT exchange that one for a different one. Practice Tires: Any and all NEW practice tires to be utilized must be purchased from Grueneberg Enterprises. No other new tires allowed from outside sources. You may mock/scuff your two (2) spare tires, however they must be put back in impound before 2pm Sat.

Fuel: Sunoco Race Fuel is the Official Race Fuel of ASAMT. There is NO fuel at the track so plan accordingly. Kwik Trip across Highway 16 does sell race gas.

Spotters: It is the responsibility of all teams participating in an ASAMT event to provide a qualified spotter. That spotter must report to the assigned spotters area prior to any on-track activities. All spotters are required to monitor race control **455.3000** via scanner/raceceiver.
