



**TECHNICAL BULLETIN**  
APPALACHIAN SUCKER PUNCH ASA STARS NATIONAL TOUR  
- 2026 -

March 9, 2026: This ASA STARS National Tour Technical Bulletin addresses technical rule adjustments and clarifications for the ASA STARS National Tour, ASA Regional Super Late Model Tours, and affiliated organizations following the United Late Model Rules Alliance (ULRA) 2026 Super Late Model Specifications & Guidelines. The diction of three rules has been adjusted, including the omission of portions of two of those rules. The implementation of this Technical Bulletin is effective immediately.

### **1) ENGINE**

Section B Engine, Rule 15 Carburetors:

Diction of Rule B.15 has been adjusted to the following – “Carburetor must be a gauge legal 750 CFM 4779, 80528 Holley permitted. No billet parts will be permitted. Carburetor must pass inspection at any time regardless of temperature. Maximum ½” carburetor spacer permitted on Chevrolet and Ford. Spacer plates cannot protrude into the intake.”

### **2) TRANSMISSION**

Section I Transmission, Rule 4:

The phrase “Any transmission that does not meet these guidelines may be assessed a minimum 25 lbs. penalty” has been omitted from Rule I.4.

All cars must adhere to the transmission rules as described in the rulebook.

### **3) ADDITIONAL RULES**

Section K Additional Rules, Rule 4 Mobile Devices:

The phrase “Smart watches or Bluetooth” has been omitted from Rule K.4 and diction has been adjusted to the following – “Cell phone devices will not be allowed in race car at any time.”
